- a. Grant Projects

- b. Schools no longer will need to do a count during their shooting days. We will continue to keep a log on the range master during public shoot days.

- e. Summer league registration will be up and running by the time high school starts. Registration fee will remain the same at \$80. Talked about doing shirts for registered kids. Will discuss it later at future meetings.
- f. We are always looking for volunteers to help run the club, as we are run by volunteers only. Asked coaches to let parents know that they are able to come and help out and even sign up for memberships and shoot as well. Some parents may not be aware of this.
